PROCEDURES FOR EXPORTING A HORSE FROM JAMAICA.

The following are the steps to be taken when exporting a horse.

- Contact the Racing Commission's Veterinarian to ascertain relevant Veterinary details.
- Apply to the Ministry of Agriculture for permission to export.

Upon processing your application, the Veterinary Division will present the applicant with a Veterinary Health Certificate.

- Apply to the Jamaica Racing Commission for the Exportation Certificate (form available at the Commission's office, and fee required).
- Maintain contact with your broker/agent and the Veterinary Division of the Ministry of agriculture to arrange the shipment of the animal.
- Present the Health Certificate to the Commission, who will then issue and forward an Exportation Certificate to the Racing Authority of the country that the horse is being exported to.

Notes:

- 1. The horse being exported must be REGISTERED by the Jamaica Racing Commission.
- 2. Please be advised that the relevant transfer document must be lodged with the Commission prior to us issuing the Exportation Certificate, so as to facilitate the issuing of this Certificate in the correct owner's name.
